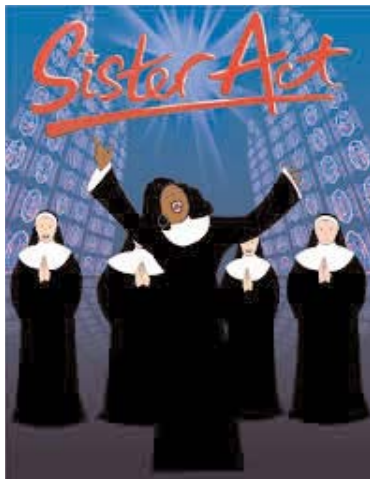


November 4 - 5, 2015

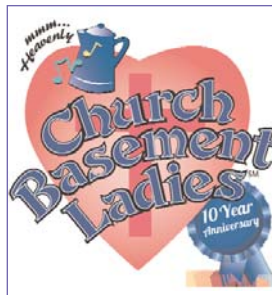
Later, check into the Country Inn and Suites, Chanhassen. Tonight we have reservations for dinner and the musical comedy

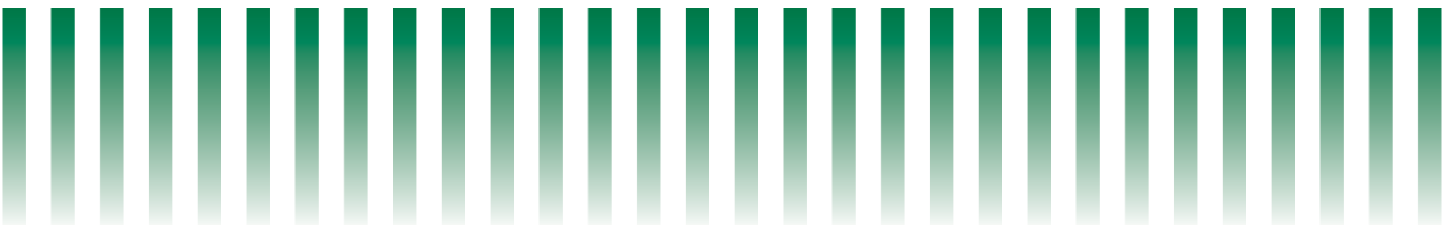
